<p>3. Update on TBT: Teacher based training is going well. The 4 learning dispositions with the “I can” and “we” statements have been put on posters and are being displayed throughout the school. The school has also finished the first two of six professional developments with staff. The current work is “deconstructing the standards and bundling them to create themes in each content area.” This will allow a teacher to instruct primarily in one subject instead of three different areas for three different grades, allowing for standards to be taught in more depth. (For example, if a science classroom has students from grades 6, 7, & 8, there could be a three year cycle where some students get life science in 6th, some in 7th, and some in 8th. The next year physical science would be taught to all three levels. In a three year cycle, all students will be instructed in three sciences.) In addition to the yearly primary subject, there will be some individualization for each grade level to be taught additional standards unique to them.</p>		
4. Update on IXL Progress Monitoring Program: Natalie Felty who is currently leading the TBI with teachers along with Matt Eberle will be attending a local IXL conference in Columbus to become more fluent in the program and learn which reports can be run to track growth and progress.
