To Parents/Guardians of Current 6th-11th Grade Students,

On Tuesday, February 8th from 6:00pm-7:00pm, Oakstone Academy High School & Oakstone Community School will be hosting an informative meeting about Ohio's *College Credit Plus Program*. This meeting is for all current 6th grade - 11th grade students who will be in grades 7-12 next school year (2022-23).

If your child is planning on or is interested in taking college classes through dual-enrollment at the high school, online or on a college campus with Central Ohio Technical College (COTC), Ohio Christian University, Otterbein University or another local university, then you need to attend this meeting. If your student is taking college classes currently, has in the past, and plans to in the future as well, **you still need to attend this meeting --- Attendance is Required.** College Credit Plus guidelines require all parents to be informed of the new laws and regulations of College Credit Plus for the upcoming school year - regardless if your child has or has not taken college classes before.

Continuing through the 2022-23 school year, all 7th-12th grade students will be eligible to take college courses at high school, on college campuses and online. This can help your student earn college and high school credits at the same time by taking college courses from community colleges or universities. The purpose of this program is to promote rigorous academic pursuits and to provide a wide variety of options to college-ready students.

For the 2022-23 school year, if you are a student in grades 7-12, you can apply for College Credit Plus admission to a public or participating private college. The individual college will admit you based on your college-readiness in one or more subject areas. These may be done through the ACCUPLACER placement tests, ACT/SAT scores, or other college-readiness admission requirements.

If you are interested in your student participating in the College Credit Plus Program next school year, then this meeting is mandatory to attend.
