- b) Curriculum and Accountability-Report-Jere Corven told the board the committee met December 2nd. A teacher gave a Google Classroom demo, showing how the app differentiates instruction for student ability. The committee also had updates on Teacher-Based Teamwork with the Four Learning Dispositions (Adaptable, Dispersible, Curious, Perseverance) and the School Improvement Plan. After attending a professional development conference, it was decided work for the SIP is needed based on the philosophy of Efficacy before Clarity. Efficacy focuses on the impact educators' beliefs have on student learning. The next committee meeting is scheduled for February 10<sup>th</sup>.
