3. Update on the August 2020 graduation: Kevin Brackman did an unbelievable job in designing a socially distant graduation that allowed students to receive their diplomas in person and allowed families to be present. His efforts are to be applauded.		
4. Update on the plan for reopening the 2020-2021 school year: Superintendent Kronewetter outlined a detailed plan for reopening the school year with an abundance of safety measures. At this point in time 55 students are planning to meet in person and 15 students have elected remote learning due to transportation issues or family health concerns. Their online time will be closely monitored to make sure they are meeting standards set by the state. In person planning includes providing for daily temperature taking, hand sanitizing, social distancing, and a detailed plan for assigning seats, transitioning safely from class to class, eating lunch, etc. Extra monies have been spent on more student desks, disposable head phones, more distance learning "tools" should it be necessary for all students to learn remotely for a time, attorney consultations to ensure all guidelines are being interpreted correctly and followed wisely, and a number of other items needed to meet student needs. The committee was impressed at the level of detailed planning and time taken to guard the students' health and safety.
